SUBJECT: 2010 NCBIA WINTER CODE SEMINARS

The NCBIA Education Committee is proud to offer three Winter Code Seminars for 2010. Our goal this year is to provide comprehensive continuing education for multi-trade inspectors. Building Code training will be offered on Monday. Cross-training will be offered on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for Building and other trades.

Building: The transition from the NC Accessibility Code to ANSI A117.1 will create some challenges for Code Officials. Monday will start off with an Accessibility presentation (Building Ch 11 primarily, 10, 34, App E). You will receive instruction on Wall and Roof Covering (Building Ch 14, 15, Residential Ch 7, 9). The day will conclude with a Deck Construction session (Residential App M).

Building/Plumbing: The focus on Tuesday morning will be an Accessibility presentation (ANSI A117.1) connecting the Code scoping requirements to the ANSI technical requirements. We will continue in the afternoon with a presentation on Water Conservation Systems (Energy, Plumbing Ch 4, App C). The day will conclude with a Q&A session.

Building/Fire/Mechanical: Smoke Partitions are a new concept introduced in the last Code cycle. Wednesday morning's topic will be on Shafts, Barriers and Partitions (Building Ch 7, Fire Ch 7, Mechanical Ch 6). Fire and Smoke Damper requirements will be presented after lunch (Building Ch 7, Mechanical Ch 6). The day will conclude with a Q&A session.

Building/Electrical: Arc Fault Circuit Interruptors have been a center of debate lately. The topic for Thursday morning will be Electrical Energy, Photoluminescence and LED Lighting (Building Ch 10, Energy, Electrical). You will receive information on AFCI, GFCI and Receptacle Location (Building Ch 27, Electrical).

We welcome all inspectors, contractors, and design professionals. Daily registration is available if you cannot attend the entire seminar. We hope you will take advantage of one these valuable educational opportunities.
